Collections are taken home to share with their parents for a certificate of completion.</p> <p>8th grade Students continue the collection process to prepare for their first formal showcase in June. Interview questions are centered around accomplishments in Junior high school and goals for high school.</p> <p>9th grade Students are introduced to the digital portfolio template and begin their formal paper portfolios.</p> <p>10th grade Students continue both paper and digital portfolios while converting from a paper platform to a digital platform. They present their digital portfolios in showcase interviews in April.</p> <p>11th grade Students present their paper portfolios for Junior Career for a Day interviews. They have the opportunity to do job shadowing. Students have the option of completing a digital portfolio.</p> <p>12th grade Students will use their paper portfolios for showcases in December. Senior portfolios and interviews are completed during first semester, enabling students to use their skills in the college application and interview process.</p>
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
